Under health and safety law we <u>all</u> have a duty to do all that is reasonably practical to ensure the health, safety and welfare of anyone that may be harmed by our work activities or our work space. It is therefore a requirement of our Terms & Conditions that each stallholder completes and submits a risk assessment form. This needs to be submitted in good time before the show along with proof of your Public Liability Insurance, minimum cover of £5 million.

My stand has adequate exits which will be available, unobstructed and unlocked at all times when the stand is in use.		
I have adequate fire extinguishers/fire blankets, they have been maintained as required, they're easily seen and available for use. NB The Craft Marquee and Shopping Mall will be furnished with its own set of fire extinguishers, however we		

ask traders to consider carrying their own, particularly where	
flammable/combustible materials are involved.	
My staff have been trained on what to do in case of fire.	
I have identified combustible materials and have reduced the risk of them being	
involved in an incident.	
The structure, roof, walls and fittings of my stand are flame retardant. Are	
certificates of compliance available?	
I have adequate provision for managing rubbish and have considered fire safety in	
how I manage this.	
I know that generators are not permitted in the Craft Marquee or Shopping Mall.	
I know that candles must not be lit in the Craft Marquee or Shopping Mall, nor any	
other form of naked flame be present.	

LPG

I understand that the use of LPG is not permitted in the Craft Marquee or Shopping Mall.

Please note: By completing and signing this form you have read the following points and agree that you have taken all reasonable actions to meet each point where applicable:

- We hold appropriate Public Liability insurance (required) and Employer Liability insurance (if required) for the duration of the event.
- Where we are providing any food or beverage, we have a HACCP in place, our staff are appropriately trained and we will display allergen information.
- We understand that the sale or provision of alcohol is not allowed in the Craft Marquee or Shopping Mall.
- All items/produce for sale will be labelled according to British and European regulations and legislation in force at the time of the Show.
- We have brought to the attention of the show organiser any other information that may give rise to a hazard or concern at the Show.
- Upon arrival at the Show our staff will familiarise themselves with any potential risks on site and any emergency information.
- Anyone involved with our stand has been given sufficient information, instruction and training to enable them to work in a competent and safe manner.

- All staff, including contractors and sub-contractors have been informed of potential risks on site.
- We will comply with all rules and regulations of the Show (available at www.monmouthshow.co.uk/traders) which we have read and understand.
- We have completed the following Risk Assessment and understand the requirement for ensuring that the necessary controls for eliminating or minimising risk are put in place.
- We will ensure that all regulations are met and no claims against the Society will be considered.
- Any incidents occurring within the area that we are located should and will be reported to an official of the Society immediately.
